Please remember for ALL exterior modifications you must submit to the ACC prior to the work beginning. Tree removal requires a permit from the City of Woodstock to be submitted with your ACC request. All modification forms can be found on the brookshirehoa.com website under the ACC tab, The ACC meets once a month to review the request. Spring Reminder



As we look forward to the warmer weather and spending more time outside, now is a great time to address some of the maintenance issues. It is important that everyone maintain their home to a high standard to keep our property values in the community up. There are several items that are quick fixes and make a huge difference on the curb appeal of your home.

- LAWN Please make sure you use this time to pretreat weeds in your yard and apply a pre-emergent to all the sod areas. The bed areas should all have fresh pine straw or mulch applied so that no dire or ground is visible. All borders or edging should be in good condition or should be repaired or replaced. Please remove all fallen leaves out of your yard and bed areas.
- **TREES** Many residents have inquired about removing the large trees in the front yards. To remove the tree for any reason, you must submit an application and a required City Permit to the ACC for review prior to removal. The ACC prefers that if you can to replace a tree. If you do not replace with a smaller tree in the same area, the stumps must be ground and removed and sod replaced in that area.
- **HOME EXTERIOR** The homes in the community are at the age where the exterior of the homes are in need of pressure washing and painting. Please make sure that you inspect the exterior of your home and pressure wash as needed. Make sure the trim is in good condition, and if necessary submit an application to the ACC for exterior house painting. Homes cannot be painted without prior approval. Applications for exterior painting can be found on the website.
- MAILBOXES The new mailboxes look great! There are two approved mailboxes for the community. The 4" wooden post with a black box and the new decorative mailbox. The order form for the new mailboxes can also be found on the website.
- **FENCES** Please pressure wash older fences and make any necessary repairs to the boards where needed. If you wish to stain your fence a color please submit an ACC request.
- TRASH CANS Reminder that trash cans should be stored out of street and neighboring lot views on non-service days. If your trashcan can be seen from the street or neighboring lots, we encourage you to build an enclosure to hide the trash cans. This makes a huge impression on the community to not see trash cans outside of the homes. Please submit an ACC Application prior to installing enclosures.

CMA will begin their spring drive through of the community this month and will be addressing the issues noted above. Please review the Declaration of Covenants to review the Rules and Restrictions for the community. Community documents can also be found on the website. www.brookshirehoa.com
